



Declaration of Intent
No Gift Policy
2026 Fiscal Year

I, Dr. Kusak Bumrungsena , Chief of Narathiwat Provincial Public Health Office , in the capacity of the Chief Executive, hereby declare a No Gift Policy and the intention of all administrators, officers, and personnel will not accept all forms of gifts and benefits before, during, and after the performance of their duties that will encourage current and future corruption and wrongful conducts. We will join forces in creating an organizational culture of honesty, fostering and raising awareness of positive attitudes and values in the performance of duties, and the ability to automatically differentiate between public and private interests, putting public interests over personal interests, cultivating public spirit and public mind consciousness, performing duties with integrity, transparency, fairness and without discrimination, refraining from any act that may create a conflict of interest between public and private interests and from accepting any asset or benefit that may be convertible to financial value beyond the asset or benefit that can be justly obtained under the laws, rules or regulations issued by virtue of the provisions of law, except for the acceptance of gifts or benefits that are permitted by ethical reasons under the criteria and quantity determined by the National Anti-Corruption Commission. We will strictly adhere to the ethical standards of government officials, the Ministry of Public Health's Code of Conduct, and guidelines for the giving or receiving of gifts or benefits for the Ministry of Public Health's officials in all positions and at all levels, including the related laws, regulations, and Cabinet resolutions in order to achieve the goals of "Zero Corruption and Wrongful Conducts MOPH" and "MOPH Together Against Corruption".
